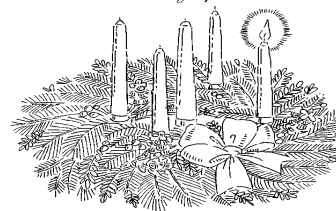
I want to express my deep appreciation to those who have made pledges of financial support for our church for the coming year. After a rather slow start, there has now been a good response, and it is a great encouragement.

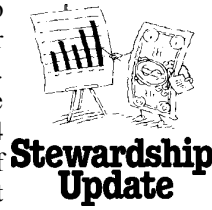
First Sunday of Advent

Thanks for Your Pledge!

As of Monday, November 26, we have 162 pledges for \$475,004 toward next year's budget of \$509,155, and 93% of the budget is pledged. Chancel Choir Advent Celebration Service

The season of Advent is upon us once again and is a joyous time of celebration. We look forward to the remembrance of Jesus Christ's birth on Christmas day, we prepare our homes and hearts reminding ourselves of the purpose and significance of His coming, and we celebrate with gatherings of family and friends and special opportunities for worship. Sunday morning, December 9, will be just such an occasion. On that day the Chancel Choir, accompanied by B. J. Mauldin and a professional string quintet, will present the Advent /Christmas portion of the beloved oratorio "Messiah," by George Frideric Handel. The work has thrived because it consists of the timeless truth of the inspired words of Scripture coupled with profoundly sublime musical settings. The choir will present this musical offering in both the 8:45 and 11:00 a.m. services. This special service presents an excellent opportunity to invite and bring friends and family to church, or to introduce someone to the Lord, Jesus Christ, through the avenue of seasonal music.



Service of Lessons and Carols

The following Sunday, December 16, at 5:00 p.m., will present another opportunity to celebrate the season of Advent and will be led by the youth and children of our church. In our annual service of Lessons and Carols all of our children's and youth vocal and instrumental ensembles will mark the occasion with the singing and ringing of Christmas carols and anthems. The service is built around the ancient, yet most relevant of stories as revealed in both the Old and New Testaments of Holy scripture—the incarnation of Jesus, Christ. This service is always a highlight of our Advent celebration at First Church, and we hope you will make it a priority to attend. As in past years, a reception in the fellowship hall will immediately follow the service with refreshments for all, and a visit from Santa.
