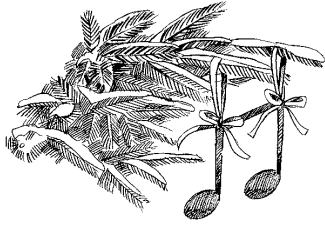

Chancel Choir “Christmas in July” Recordings Available

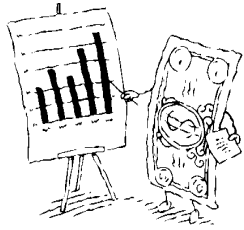
